WHEREAS, the Court has received and reviewed the parties' pleadings and declaration in Support of the parties' Joint Motion to Consolidate Related Actions and supporting papers, the Court finds that the Related Actions (as listed below and defined in the Joint Motion) involve: (a) the same parties, (b) the same class definitions, (c) the same class periods, and (d) identical claims for relief. The Court further finds that consolidation will eliminate inconvenience, delay, or expense for the litigants and this Court and that consolidation at this time will also promote judicial efficiency with respect to the pending MDL proceedings. Accordingly, pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 42(a) and Local Rule 7.1(d)(1),
