**THIS MATTER** having come before the Court on the motion of plaintiff, Stacy Orlick, to consolidate the above referenced cases (Docket #26 in 12-2531), which motion is opposed by plaintiff, Ian Steiner (Docket #34 in 12-2531); and

**IT APPEARING THAT** on or about April 27, 2012, the Steiner action was removed to this Court; and

**IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT** on or about August 7, 2012, Orlick filed an action against Rawlings seeking similar relief in the United States District Court for the Central District of California (“Orlick” action); and

**IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT** in March 2013, Steiner and Rawlings appeared before the undersigned and the action was tentatively resolved on a global nationwide basis, subject to approval by this Court; and

**IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT** on or about May 20, 2013, the Orlick action was transferred to this Court; and

**IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT** on or about June 3, 2013, the parties in Steiner filed a joint motion for preliminary approval of settlement; and

**IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT** on or about June 14, 2013, Orlick's counsel objected to the preliminary approval of the Steiner settlement and filed her motion to consolidate the Orlick action with the Steiner action; and

**IT FURTHER APPEARING THAT** this Court should exercise its discretion to stay the second filed Orlick action, pending resolution of the first filed Steiner action, Worthington v. Bayer Health Care, L.L.C., 2012 WL 1079716 At \*8 (D.N.J. March 20, 2012); and for good cause shown;

**IT IS on this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2013,**

**ORDERED** that:

1. The Orlick action is hereby stayed pending resolution of the Steiner case. The Clerk's Office shall administratively terminate Orlick v. Rawlings Sporting Goods, 13-3231.
