ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Plaintiff's Application to Stay All Proceedings Pending Finalization of the Nationwide Settlement be and same hereby is GRANTED. All dates and deadlines currently set by the Local Rules of the Southern District of California, the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, or Court order are hereby vacated until further order by this Court. During the pendency of the stay, no party shall be required to provide discovery, disclose information pursuant to Rule 26(a), or hold a scheduling conference pursuant to Rule 26(f).


However, this shall not be construed to prohibit the voluntary exchange of information between the parties.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this action is hereby removed from this Court's active caseload until further application by the parties or order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel shall file a proper stipulation for dismissal or a joint report detailing settlement status within **60 days** and every quarter thereafter until a stipulation for dismissal is filed.

This Court retains full jurisdiction over this action and this Order shall not prejudice any party to this action. All dates in this action are hereby **VACATED**
