ORDER

On April 30, 2016, this Court granted plaintiff's March 20, 2016 Motion to Withdraw Legal Representation (d.e. 29). In that Order (d.e. 36), we noted that plaintiff had submitted no other filings during this calendar year and that plaintiff had failed to attend a deposition scheduled for March 29, 2016. We ordered plaintiff to inform the Court no later than May 27, 2016 as to the contact information of his new attorney, or in the alternative, whether he wishes to continue *pro se*. We admonished him that failure to comply with the Order may result in dismissal of this action. Ten weeks have passed since we entered that Order, and six weeks have passed since the deadline set forth therein. Plaintiff has failed to comply. As a result of plaintiff's noncompliance, defendant Ghirardelli Chocolate Company's Motion to Dismiss under Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b) (d.e. 30) is GRANTED. Judgment will be entered dismissing plaintiff's Complaint in its entirety, with prejudice.
