**ORDER CONFIRMING SETTLEMENT
AND SETTING DEADLINE TO FILE
JOINT MOTION FOR DISMISSAL**

On June 4, 2015, the Court held a telephonic Case Management Conference in the above-entitled action. ECF No. 75. The case settled. Id. Because the case has settled, all other pending dates before Magistrate Judge Major are hereby vacated. Any matters currently scheduled before the district judge shall remain in effect pending notice from that court.

The parties are ordered to file their joint motion for dismissal of this case, signed by counsel of record and any unrepresented parties, no later than **July 9, 2015**. A proposed order on the joint motion for dismissal must be e-mailed to the district judge's chambers¹ on the same day. If the signed joint motion for dismissal is timely filed, the parties and attorneys are not required to make any further appearances before Judge Major.

1 If the fully executed joint motion for dismissal is not filed by July 9, 2015, then all
2 counsel of record and unrepresented parties are required to appear in person for a Settlement
3 Disposition Conference. The Settlement Disposition Conference will be held on July 16, 2015
4 at 9:30 a.m. in Courtroom 1B.

5 If counsel of record or any unrepresented party fails to appear at the Settlement
6 Disposition Conference, or the parties fail to file the signed joint motion for dismissal in a timely
7 manner, the Court will issue an order to show cause why sanctions should not be imposed for
8 failing to comply with this Order.
