ORDER

Upon reviewing the responses to this court's February 3, 2017 order to show cause, we dismiss this appeal for lack of jurisdiction.

Appellant's request for judicial notice in support of appellant's alternative request for mandamus relief (Docket Entry No. 6) is granted. *See United States v. Howard*, 381 F.3d 873, 876 n.1 (9th Cir. 2004) (court may take judicial notice of court records in another case). Because appellant has filed a separate petition for writ of mandamus, *see* petition No. 17-70614, appellant's alternative request for mandamus relief (Docket Entry No. 7) is denied as unnecessary.

All other pending motions are denied as moot.

DISMISSED.
