Last January, I wrote to you to notify ABC of a false and deceptive advertising campaign for the supplement Prevagen (owned by Quincy Bioscience LLC) airing on your network. That letter is attached for your reference.

I am now writing to you to inform you that the Federal Trade Commission and New York State Attorney General jointly filed a lawsuit in New York federal court against Quincy Bioscience for its false advertising of Prevagen. The complaint is attached.

In light of today's filing, we trust ABC will now cease airing what New York Attorney General Eric Schneiderman has called "[clear-cut fraud](#)."
