- Apigenin (/search/products.aspx?k=dptApigenin): 20 50 mg daily.
- Astragalus (/search/products.aspx?k=dptAstragalus): 2000 4000 mg daily.
- Blueberry (/search/products.aspx?k=dptBlueberry): 900 1800 mg daily.
- Chrysin (/search/products.aspx?k=dptChrysin): 1000 2000 mg daily.
- Coffee (/search/products.aspx?k=dptCoffee): 400 mg, three times daily.
- Cruciferous vegetable extract (/search/products.aspx?k=dptCruciferous): 1 2 capsules per day.
- Curcumin (/search/products.aspx?k=dptCurcumin): 400 mg three times daily (as highly absorbable BCM-95™).
- Lightly caffeinated green tea extract (/search/products.aspx?k=dptGreenTea): three 725 mg capsules, two times a day with meals. Use decaffeinated green tea extract if you are sensitive to caffeine or want to use a less-stimulating version with the evening dosage.
- CLA or CLA with guarana (/search/products.aspx?k=dptCLA): 3000 4000 mg daily of CLA and about 300 mg of guarana, early in the day.
- Lignans (/search/products.aspx?k=dpt114098Lignans): 75 125 mg daily.
- Melatonin (/search/products.aspx?k=dptMelatonin): 3 50 mg at bedtime.
- Pomegranate (/search/products.aspx?k=dptPomegranate): 280 375 mg daily of punicalagins.
- Powders (/search/products.aspx?k=dptmixpowder) (broccoli, cabbage, and other cruciferous vegetables that provide sulforaphane and other cancer-fighting plant extracts): 1 – 2 tbsp daily.
- **PSK** (from the mushroom *Coriolus versicolor*): 3 g daily.
- **Pterostilbene** (/search/products.aspx?k=dptPterostilbene): 1 3 mg daily.
- Quercetin (/search/products.aspx?k=dptQuercetin): 1000 3000 mg daily.
- Se-methylselenocysteine (/search/products.aspx?k=dptSeMC): 200 400 mcg daily.
- Sulforaphane (/search/products.aspx?k=dptSulforaphane): 400 1600 mg daily of a broccoli extract.
- CoQ10 (/search/products.aspx?k=dptCoQ10) (as ubiquinol): three 100 mg softgels in divided doses. Note the caution stated in this protocol.
- EPA/DHA (/search/products.aspx?k=dptEPADHA) (with sesame lignans): 2 4 grams daily. Take with nonfiber meals.
- Vitamin D3 (/search/products.aspx?k=dptVitaminD3): 4000 6000 IU taken daily with monthly blood testing to monitor for toxicity. Reduce dosage at 6 months.
- Water-soluble vitamin A (/search/products.aspx?k=dptvitaminAwatersoluble): 100000 300000 IU daily with monthly blood testing to monitor for toxicity. Reduce dosage at 6 months.
- Vitamin E (/search/products.aspx?k=dptVitaminE): succinate (tocopheryl succinate), 1200 IU daily.
- Gamma tocopherol (/search/products.aspx?k=dptGammaEHigh): 1 capsule daily.
- Vitamin C (/search/products.aspx?k=dptVitaminC): 4000 12000 mg throughout the day.
- Gamma linolenic acid (/search/products.aspx?k=dptMegaGLA): 299 1495 mg daily
- Whey protein concentrate-isolate (/search/products.aspx?k=dptwheyprotein): 30 60 g daily in divided doses.
- Calcium (/search/products.aspx?k=dptcalcium): 1000 1200 mg daily
- Magnesium (/search/products.aspx?k=dptmagnesium): 200 1000 mg daily
- Vitamin K (/search/products.aspx?k=dptVitaminK): 10 mg daily.
- **Silicon** (/search/products.aspx?k=dptSilicon): 6 mg daily.
- Multinutrient formula (/search/products.aspx?k=dptmultivitaminmineral): daily.

Reminder: Bisphosphonate (injectable Zometa or Aredia) drug therapy is strongly encouraged for all breast cancer patients as well as aromatase-inhibitor therapy (Arimidex, Femara, or Aromasin) if appropriate.

Note: If chemotherapy and/or radiation are being considered, refer to the Cancer Chemotherapy and Cancer Radiation protocols. Also refer to the protocols titled Cancer Treatment: The Critical Factors and Cancer Adjuvant Therapy.
