JOINT STATUS REPORT

The parties, Samantha Santiago, Plaintiff, and EOS Products, LLC (“EOS”), Defendant, by and through their undersigned counsel, hereby submit this joint status report as an update to the parties’ Joint Status Report filed on December 29, 2017 (Dkt. No. 48), and to advise the Court of the current status.

Plaintiff’s complaint is one of several putative class actions filed against EOS asserting similar claims based on the same alleged underlying conduct. *See Cronin v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 2:16-cv-00235-JAK-JEM (C.D. Cal.); *Caggiano v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 1:16-cv-00408 (S.D.N.Y.); *Bevins v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 2:16-cv-00066-GCS-TPK (S.D. Oh.); *Everett v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 8:16-cv-00140-JSM-TGW (M.D. Fla.); *Tipirneni v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 2:16-cv-02022-CSB-EIL (C.D. Ill.); *Menz v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 8:16-cv-00128-SDM-JSS (M.D. Fla.); *Jones v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 1:16-cv-00321-JKB (D. Md.); *Gilsleider v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 8:16-cv-00283-AG-JCG (C.D. Cal.); *Ballenilla-Blondett v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 1:16-cv-01219-ALC (S.D.N.Y.); and *Gannuccelli v. EOS Products, LLC*, Case No. 1:16-cv-01358 (S.D.N.Y.).

The parties filed a motion for preliminary approval of a proposed nationwide settlement in the Central District of California on November 1, 2016, in the *Cronin* and *Gilsleider* actions. On June 29, 2017, Judge Kronstadt denied the parties' motion for preliminary approval on various grounds. The court further instructed the parties to confer regarding whether further efforts would be made to address the issues raised in the court's June 29 order.

On December 29, 2017, the parties reported to this Court they had agreed on all terms of a settlement, finalized the settlement papers, were acquiring the necessary signatures, and anticipated a further filing to resolve the case on behalf of the named plaintiff within ten days after the agreement is fully executed.

All parties have now signed off on the settlement agreement. Plaintiff will be filing a stipulated dismissal with prejudice of her individual claims pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), which will resolve this case. Plaintiff anticipates filing this stipulated dismissal with prejudice on or before January 19, 2018.
