**ORDER** 

The Court having considered Plaintiff Darrell Hunter's Motion for Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice Under Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2), Defendant's Response and Plaintiff's Reply.

IT IS ORDERED granting Plaintiff Darrell Hunter's Motion for Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice Under Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2) except that the dismissal shall be with prejudice (Doc. 50). After review of the filings by the parties, the Court concludes that notification of Plaintiff Hunter's inability to prosecute this action was known to counsel in late August yet counsel waiting nearly a month to file his Motion.
