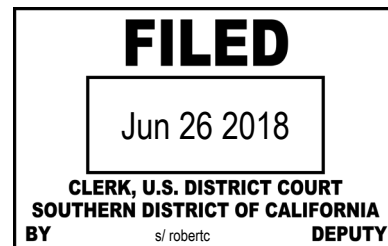

CONDITIONAL TRANSFER ORDER (CTO -1)

On June 6, 2018, the Panel transferred 2 civil action(s) to the United States District Court for the Southern District of Florida for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1407. *See* ___ F.Supp.3d ___ (J.P.M.L. 2018). Since that time, no additional action(s) have been transferred to the Southern District of Florida. With the consent of that court, all such actions have been assigned to the Honorable Darrin P. Gayles.

The transmittal of this order to said Clerk shall be stayed 7 days from the entry thereof. If any party files a notice of opposition with the Clerk of the Panel within this 7-day period, the stay will be continued until further order of the Panel.

Inasmuch as no objection is pending at this time, the stay is lifted.
