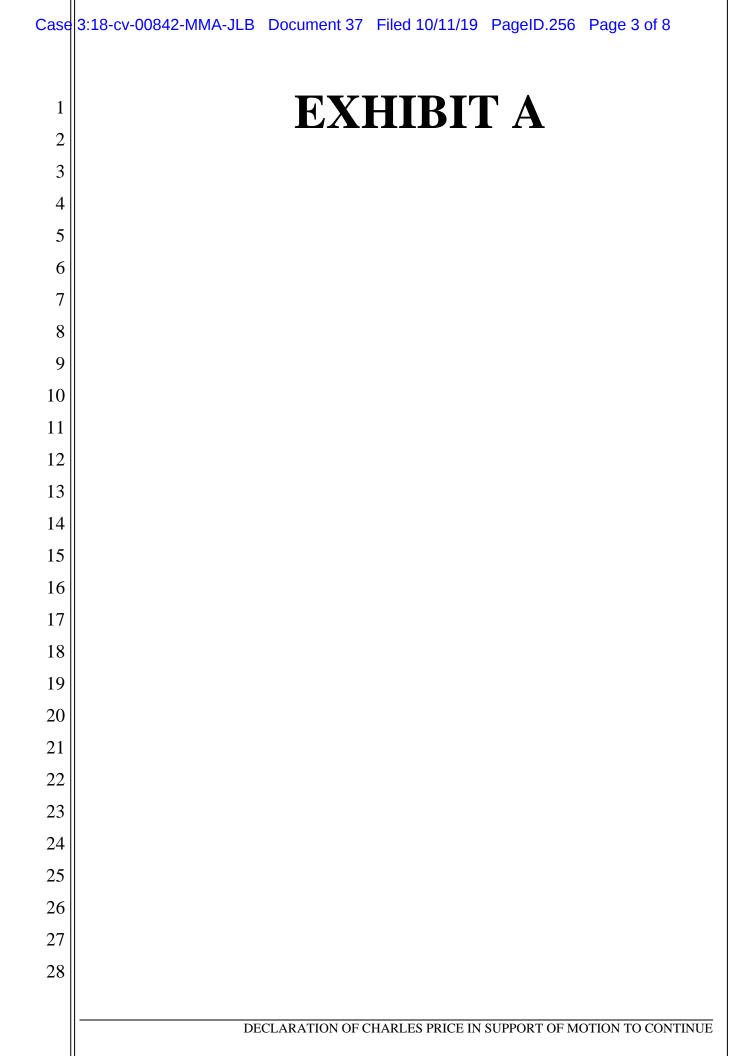

Nothing herein shall 16 constitute a waiver of the Debtor's rights to assert any claims, counterclaims, defenses, 17 18 rights of setoff or recoupment, or any other claims against any party to the abovecaptioned cases. The Debtor expressly reserves all rights to contest any claim that may 19 be asserted against it. 20
