ORDER

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on the parties' Joint Notice of Agreement to Transfer Case (Doc. 41; Notice). The Notice follows the Court's Order to Show Cause as to why this matter should not be transferred to the Orlando Division. (Doc. 39). The parties conferred and agreed that this case should be transferred to the Orlando Division. Notice at 1. All civil proceedings of any kind, "shall be instituted in that Division encompassing the county . . . having the greatest nexus with the cause" Local Rule 1.02(c). As the Court previously noted, the only tie that appears to link this case to the Middle District of Florida is in Volusia County, which is encompassed by the Orlando Division. See Local Rule 1.02(b)(3). "The Court may, within its discretion, or upon good cause shown by any interested party, order that any case, civil or criminal, be transferred from one Division to any other Division for trial, or from one place of holding court to another place of holding court in the same Division." Local Rule 1.02(e). The parties' agreement that this case should be transferred to the Orlando Division in light of


Orlando having the greatest nexus to this case provides good cause for the transfer of this case to the Orlando Division.

Accordingly, after due consideration, it is

ORDERED:

The Clerk of the Court shall **TRANSFER** this case to the Orlando Division of the Middle District of Florida, United States District Court. Following transfer of this case, the Clerk of the Court shall close the Jacksonville file and terminate all pending motions.
