**PROCEEDINGS: (IN CHAMBERS) ORDER DEEMING SECOND AMENDED
COMPLAINT WITHDRAWN (Doc. 37)**

On June 17, 2019, the Court ordered Plaintiff to show cause why the Court should not deem her Second Amended Complaint (Doc. 37) withdrawn and set a response date of five days from the Court's Order (effectively June 24, 2019, per Fed.
