By consent of all parties, Plaintiffs' counsel are writing to the Court to advise that on December 15, 2023, the New Jersey Superior Court, in an action entitled Esposito, et al. v. <u>Cellco d/b/a Verizon Wireless</u>, Docket No. MID-L-6360-23, granted preliminary approval of a proposed nationwide class action settlement which, if given final approval at a Fairness Hearing scheduled for March 22, 2024, will resolve all claims pleaded in these <u>Corsi</u> and <u>Allen</u>, as well as all other proposed class actions currently pending against Verizon related to the "Administrative Charge." <u>See</u> Order Granting Preliminary Approval Dated December 15, 2023 in <u>Esposito</u> (attached hereto). If the proposed class action settlement is approved by the New Jersey Superior Court on March 22, 2024, the parties have agreed that the complaints in <u>Corsi</u> and <u>Allen</u> will be voluntarily dismissed immediately thereafter. Accordingly, all parties to this matter have agreed to jointly request that Your Honor administratively stay these two pending federal matters until April 1, 2024. At that time, if the proposed class action settlement has been approved by the New Jersey Superior Court, Plaintiffs in both these federal actions will be filing a voluntary dismissal of those actions.
