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("Defendants") filed a joint motion to transfer this case pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §1404(a). (Doc. No. 11.) The parties request the case be transferred to the U.S. District Court of Connecticut in light of a related case pending in that district, Lazo v. Henkel Corp., No. 3:21-cv-1702. (Id.) On January 31, 2022, the parties filed a joint motion for an extension of time for Defendants to respond to Plaintiffs' complaint due to the parties' motion to transfer this case. (Doc. No. 12.) For good cause shown, the Court grants the parties' motions. The Court grants Defendants a thirty (30) day extension of time to respond to Plaintiffs' complaint.
