Plaintiff voluntarily dismisses all claims except the Illinois Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act ("ICFA") Claim. The remaining claims and the Multi–State Class are dismissed with prejudice. As to the remaining claim (the ICFA claim), defendant's motion to dismiss [18] is granted for the reasons stated on the record. Plaintiff is given until 9/25/2024 to file an amended complaint or a status report that indicates whether or not plaintiff will be filing an amended complaint, or whether plaintiff needs additional time to decide whether to file an amended complaint.
