
20 On December 27, 2023, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Dismiss Individual Claims
21 with Prejudice Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) (“Joint Motion
22 to Dismiss”), in which “Plaintiff Heidi Anderberg and Defendant The Hain Celestial
23 Group, Inc., by and through their undersigned attorneys, ... stipulate and agree to the
24 dismissal of this action with prejudice as to Plaintiff Anderberg’s individual claims and
25 without prejudice as to the claims of the proposed class members.” (Doc. 51 at 2.) The
26 Joint Motion to Dismiss indicates that “[e]ach party shall bear its own attorneys’ fees and
27 costs.” (*Id.*)

28 The Court **GRANTS** the parties’ Joint Motion to Dismiss. The Court **DISMISSES**

1 Plaintiff Anderberg's individual claims with prejudice. The Court also **DISMISSES** the
2 claims of the proposed class members without prejudice. Each party shall bear its own
3 attorneys' fees and costs. The Clerk shall close this case.
